- Members congratulated the team on the performance of Campus West.
- It was clarified that the maximum capacity for Live on Stage was 326, however, seating was often required by the crew for shows.
- During school holidays children's theatre was shown at Campus West which had good attendance.
- The net controllable costs in the report show the subsidy for Camp West.
- Members commented that the Pumping Station at Mill Green would be a valuable asset to the Council. It was confirmed that the public and organisations could also hire the space.
- It was highlighted that for future meetings the Hive and the other community centres would be shown separately.
