## 2 TITLE OF REPORT

Award of Footways contract.

#### 3 <u>DECISION TAKEN</u>

To award a three-year contract, with the option to extend by one year, commencing on 1 October 2022 to Henderson & Taylor Public Works Limited for Footway repairs.

#### 6 **EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND:**

- 6.1 The council owns and has maintenance responsibilities for a number of footways and other hardstanding areas. There is also a requirement to install new hardstanding and pathways from time to time. The current contract expires at the end of September 2022 and a new contract is required to be put in place so that the various user departments can call off from the framework.
- 6.2 In February 2022, the General Procurement Board agreed the evaluation criteria and term of contract (3 years with a possible one-year extension) for the footways repair contract.
- 6.3 Following an open tender process, Henderson and Taylor Public Works Limited scored the highest against the evaluation criteria. The scoring can be found in Appendix 1.

#### 6.4 Legal Implications:

The procurement has been undertaken in accordance with the Public Contracts Regulations 2015.

## 6.5 Financial Implications:

The contract is based on schedule of rates with each requirement being called off as required. With CPI added the prices this year are 24.87% less than the last tendered rates in 2018. This would equate to a saving of approximately £57,000.00 per annum, assuming the same usage.

#### 6.6 Risk Implications:

As with all procurements, there is a risk of challenge by the unsuccessful bidder.

6.7 <u>Alternative options considered and reasons for their rejection (if any)</u>:

The service could be delivered in house, but the council does not have the infrastructure to do this so this option was rejected.
