

Council Direct Construction

The Council has obtained planning approval on two former garage sites at Garden Avenue and Furzen Crescent in Hatfield. Mears New Homes have been selected as construction partner to deliver Garden Avenue with a start on site expected imminently. A formal opening event is being arranged.

Furzen Crescent has been tendered and evaluation of the bids completed. A recommendation for the selection of construction partner was made to July Cabinet following Procurement Board consideration on the 21st June

A planning application has been submitted for the provision of 16 new self contained flats in Northdown Road on the site of existing low demand bedsits. Negotiations are complete with 2 existing leaseholders, 3 tenants and the Gap Homeless charity which currently leases a bedsit.

Council and RP Open Market Purchases

We aim to purchase a total of 37 properties during 2016/17. At the time of writing six properties had been purchased a further 15 identified. We are on target to identify all 37 this financial year. Our RP partners have purchased 4 and hope to identify 14 more.

Feasibility work is being undertaken to consider providing 4 x 3 bed houses and 3 x 2 bed houses on an underused garage site.

Further Opportunities

- The Council is currently working with Home Housing Group as part of their proposal to deliver 70+ homes on part of the Onslow school site in Hatfield. A minimum of 30% of these homes must be delivered as part of the planning requirement and without grant. The council is able to fund any additional units above this percentage. Detailed negotiation with Home on exact numbers is to be agreed. A planning application is anticipated in August 2016.
- Initial discussions are being held with All Saints Church in WGC that
 may offer the opportunity to provide 9 x 2 bed houses and reprovide a
 new community facility that meets current and future use
