We intend to remove the use of flexible 5 year fixed term tenancies for our council housing residents, and replace them with lifetime secure tenancies. The aim is to reduce insecurity and uncertainty for tenants and reduce the need for resource intensive and unproductive administrative processes associated with fixed term tenancy process.
