## REVIEW OF POLITICAL PROPORTIONALITY & CABINET PORTFOLIO UPDATE

## 1 <u>Executive Summary</u>

1.1 Following a review by officers, the purpose of this report is to update Members on the political proportionality of Member appointments to Committees in light of changes in membership of the Conservative Group as of the 10<sup>th</sup> January 2025.

## 2 <u>Recommendation</u>

2.1 That the review of political proportionality of Member appointments to Committees be noted and the allocation of seats be as set out in Schedule 1 to this report.

## 3 <u>Explanation</u>

## **Political Proportionality**

- 3.1 It was necessary to review the political proportionality of Member appointments to Committees following the changes to membership of the Conservative Group.
- 3.2 In May 2024 the Conservative Group's proportion of seats across all Committees was 25% based on 12 group Members. As a result of a Conservative Member becoming an Independent Member on 10<sup>th</sup> January 2025, the proportion of Conservative seats across all Committees is now 22.92% based on 11 group Members.
- 3.3 Based on the proportions as set out in paragraph 3.2, the recommendation in this report reflects no change to the allocation of seats on Committees in May 2024. The current allocation of seats on Committees remains proportionate to each political group's membership of the Council.
- 3.4 The Council has a legal duty to secure the balance of the different political groups on the Council's Committees.

#### **Cabinet Portfolio update**

- 3.5 The Cabinet Portfolio was recently updated at Special Cabinet on 21 January 2025. The changes are set out below for information.
- 3.5.1 In addition to the current responsibilities, the Leader is also responsible for Estates, Economic Development and Business Centres.
- 3.5.2 The Resources Portfolio has been renamed as Finance. It includes Revenues and Benefits, Internal Audit and Fraud, procurement and finance.
