# SUBJECT STREET TRADING CONSENTS

LEGISLATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 1982

# POLICY

As from 2nd May 1995 the streets in the following schedule will be consent streets. All other streets will be prohibited streets.

One trader only will be granted consent at any one time in any consent street. The consents will be limited to the times shown in the schedule and where daytime and evening trading is indicated this comprises two separate consents which can be allocated to two different traders.

Only traders who will not be in competition with existing shops in the same location will be allowed, however renewals of existing consents where such a shop has opened more recently than the commencement of trading by the street trader will be decided on their merits.

The exact location of any stall within a consent street, if on the public highway will agreed with the Council's Highways Department and included in the conditions of the consent.

Where the consent is for non-highway land within the ownership of the Council (for example a car park) the Estates Division will be informed of the details so that they can negotiate their fee before the consent is issued. Any location requirements of the Estates Division will be included in the conditions of the consent.

All consents will be annual and will expire on 31st March following. The fee will be decided by Committee from year to year.

All food traders will be required to present their stall or vehicle for inspection under Food Safety Act before the consent is issued and the address of their home premises should be notified to the appropriate local authority so that they can ensure that it is registered under FSA.
