## **NOTICE OF INTENT – STATUTORY CONSULTATION**

### **THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (HILL RISE AND SUTHERLAND WAY, CUFFLEY) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2017**

During November 2016, proposals were sent to residents in Hill Rise to the junction of Highfields. The proposals included an option for residents to comment on whether they would like to see a restriction outside of their home and sections of double yellow lines in areas which the Council felt vehicles should not be parking. This included junctions and parts of the carriageway which are too narrow for vehicles to park wholly on the carriageway, and maintain safe movement of traffic for vehicles and pedestrians.

In February we wrote to you with the outcome of the consultation, the responses indicated a clear request for yellow lines in the section between Plough Hill and Sutherland Way.

Parking Services are proposing to create single yellow line restrictions in part of the road Monday to Friday 11am to 1pm. We are also proposing to place double yellow lines near junctions. A map of the proposals is on the reverse of this letter.

The legal document relating to the proposed parking restrictions is being drafted. A public notice will be published in the Welwyn and Hatfield Times on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2018. Notice boards will also be placed on near the lengths of the roads affected. Anyone wishing to object to the proposed parking restrictions may write to the Council using the details supplied in the public notice. Please respond by 27<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

All objections to the proposals will be considered by the Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel (CPPP) on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2018. CPPP will also consider Parking Service's report giving reasons for proceeding with the proposals. The recommendations made by CPPP will be considered by the Cabinet on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2018. Both meetings will be held in the Council Chamber on the ground floor of the Council Offices, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City, AL8 6AE.

Parking Services will keep any objectors informed during the decision making process. Once this process has ended, Parking Services will write to all residents in the affected area.

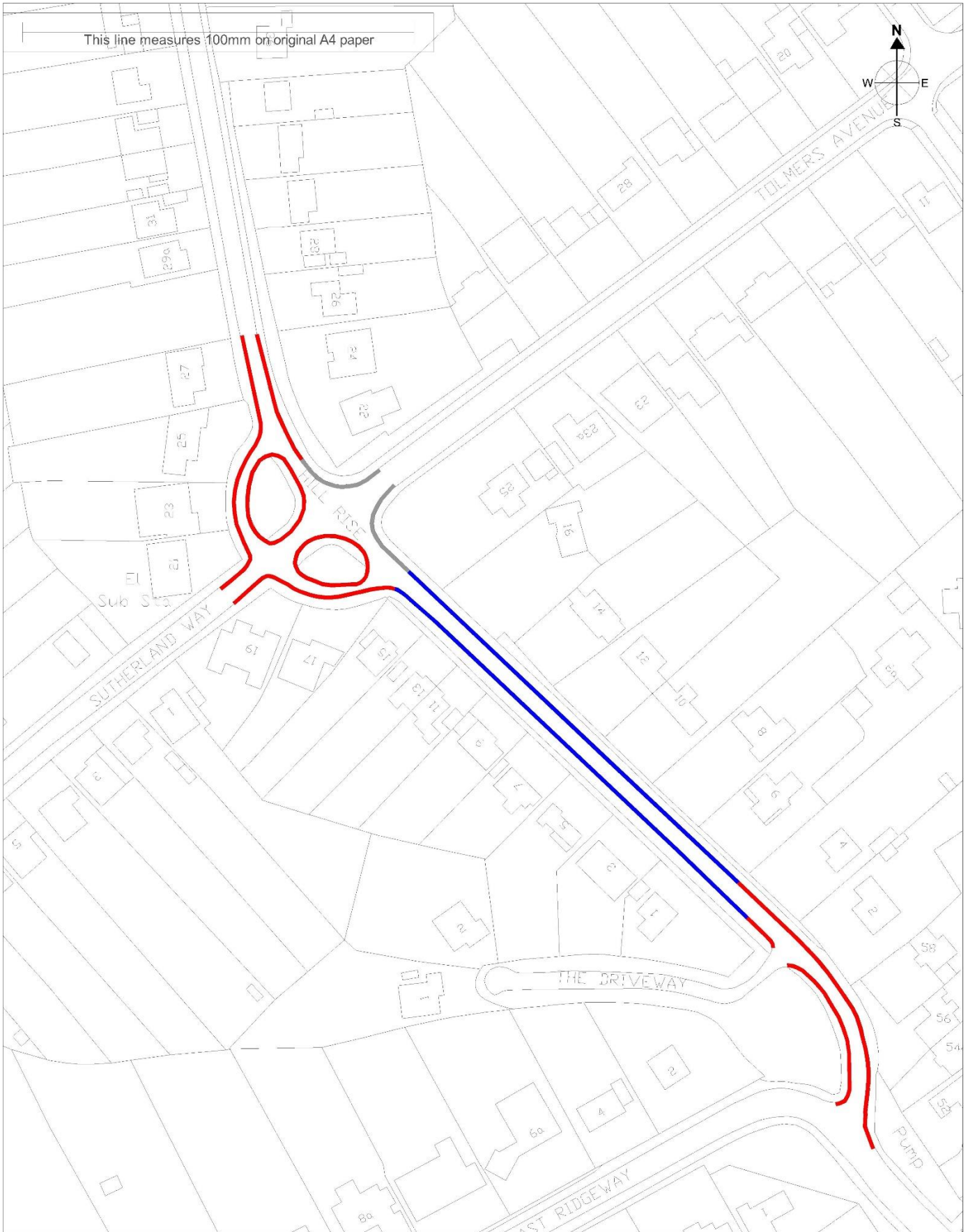

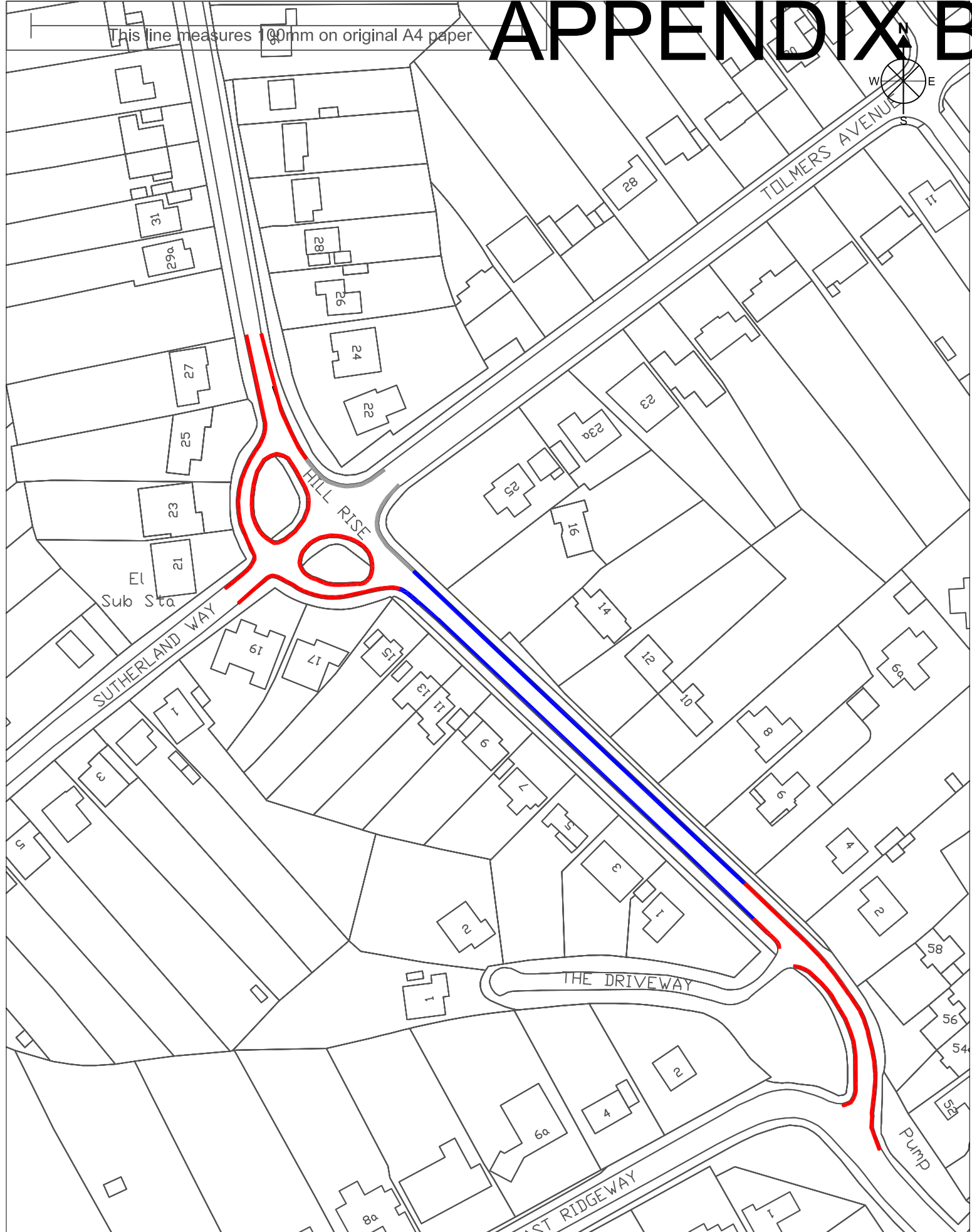

### STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

#### THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (HILL RISE AND SUTHERLAND WAY, CUFFLEY) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2017

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council is proposing to introduce “no waiting at any time” (Double Yellow Lines) and “No waiting Monday to Friday 11am to 1pm” (Single Yellow Lines) in Hill Rise and Sutherland Way, Cuffley.

The proposals are intended to prevent obstructions caused by vehicles parking too close to junctions and driveways, reduce commuter parking and to increase safety within the road.

The proposed restrictions are in the following roads;

In parts of Hill Rise and Sutherland Way

1. No waiting at any time
2. No waiting Monday – Friday 11am – 1pm

Recent parking restrictions have been introduced in parts of Cuffley and this has displaced vehicles into Hill Rise. The residents in the above roads were consulted in December 2016 on proposed restrictions to prevent parking on junctions and congestion. Residents expressed concerns about commuter parking, lack of available parking during parts of the day and obstruction to residents' properties; and safety issues with parking too close to the junction of Hill Rise and East Ridgeway.

Having considered the duty imposed by Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council consider that it is necessary and expedient to make Orders for the following reasons:-

- For the purposes of relieving or preventing congestion of traffic.
- For the avoidance of danger to persons or other traffic using the road and preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and county councillors representing the area and Hertfordshire County Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, and local residents have also been consulted.
