We plan annually so we know which events we are working towards either intra or inter sports. We are extremely active in the community and enter all events we are invited to. We send teams from Y2 to Y6 and sometimes whole year groups if the opportunity arises!

We host dance classes and provide children with information about local clubs e.g Saracens camps. Two of our children play for the District football team. Many attend football, swimming, dance, martial arts and gym clubs out of school.

We run our own clubs at lunchtime and after-school apart from FunkyKidz (dance).

In certain sports, yes. There are more boys at football and a few more girls than boys at the dance and netball club. All of the others are evenly balanced and we enter mixed teams when competing as a school.
