6 EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND:

The council is redeveloping the marketplace in Hatfield and has received planning permission for this to happen

The scheme includes:

 Improve general access and layout by looking at the removal of level change, steps and railings

- Improve lighting and surfacing and offer new seating opportunities to make the space more inviting
- Offer a diverse range of play and leisure equipment, catering for different age groups
- Provide inclusive play, tactile surfaces and leisure options
- Upgrade quality and location of vegetation, introduce more biodiversity and seasonal interest, whilst retaining the existing trees that give value to the space
- An open tender process took place and 5 bids were received and evaluated against the criteria of 50% price and 50% quality.
- 6.3 Details of the bids are included in Appendix 1. Henderson and Taylor scored the highest against the evaluation criteria
- 6.4 <u>Legal Implications</u>:
- 6.4.1 The procurement was undertaken in accordance with the councils Contract Procedure Rules which includes the requirement for an open tender for works of this value.
- 6.4.2 In line with the contract procedure rules, contracts between £100k an £1m require approval from the relevant Executive Member for the award of contract.
- 6.5 Financial Implications:
- 6.5.1 The contract figure is £607,203.53
- 6.5.2 There will be additional costs in professional fees, contingency and other incidental sums. These are estimated at £121K.
- 6.5.3 To date £75K has been spent on planning and design.
- 6.5.4 This gives a total anticipated cost for the project of £803K
- 6.5.5 The budget for the project is £850K, as shown in the 2025/26 budget papers. This budget was reviewed as part of the 2025/26 budget process and is made up of a number of sums including UKSPF 24/25 and UKPSF 25/26, along with transfers from the playgrounds budget and Hatfield Public realm budget.
- 6.5.6 It is therefore anticipated that this scheme can be delivered within the existing budget and that there is sufficient contingency within the budget to cover most anticipated eventualities.
