Next Steps Accommodation Project (NSAP - YMCA)	DLUHC	Funding for 2 properties (8 bedspaces) for individuals to develop independent living skills. Managed by YMCA	£28,000
Ex-Offenders Housing Options Officer	DLUHC/MOJ	Funding for specialist officer focussing on those leaving prison or who have left prison in the past 12 months, linking with Probation Service and Prison Service	£40,000
Ex-Offenders Funding	DLUHC/MOJ	Funding for deposits, rent in advance and incentive payments to assist prison leavers or former prisoners into accommodation.	£75,000
Single Persons Housing Options Officer	DLUHC	Funding for specialist officer focussing on single people and couples, linking with ReStart project in order to assist those who are not owed a housing duty or are former rough sleepers	£40,000
